**Presentation: On Advocacy** Various ways exist to pursue conservation goals. One way is through governmental and political structures. Starting in the 5th grade, Ohioans learn we have three levels of government each with three branches. Interaction between citizens and elected officials, or candidates, remains untaught. As the advocacy option remains unused the perception of an inability to interact reinforces itself. Why does Ohio matter? Ohio has a budget of \$27 Billion dollars a year which is larger than the budget in 160 countries around the globe. The state's budget and legislation has an influence on you, your community, and our conservation goals. 

# Ohio and term limited seats, 2014


General Assembly seats are redistricted.
