


ATTACHMENT: Chief's Order Permit Application

The brine is hauled from our production tanks at the well to the brine storage facility and placed in tanks where it is stored until it is taken by truck to be used for dust control on our haul roads. Temproary hoses are used to fill and/or empty the tanks.

The storage facility consists of seven 210bbls tanks, four 100bbls tanks and one 300bbls tank that are contained in a dike. The capacity fluctuates throughout the year, with occurrences where all tanks are completely empty, and a maximum of all tanks being full. Annual Brine Hauler Reports and Brine Disposal Reports are completed and submitted using data collected from Belden Brick's Oil and Gas Department daily logs. Belden rebuilds the dike as necessary in order to keep it at minimum one and a half times the capacity of the tanks.
