RE: Applications to Operate a Facility CMS SR 43 – Jefferson County CMS HRP – Belmont County

Dear Mr. Warren:

The Division of Oil and Gas Resource Management (DOGRM) received CMS Oilfield Services' application to operate a facility on March 7, 2014 and sent written review comments (March 13, 2014), identifying omissions and deficiencies in the application submittal. Included in the March 13th letter were a copy of the application guidelines and a list of required information that was omitted. A revised application was received on April 11, 2014, but several of the previously identified items were not provided. Please provide the information listed below that was not included or not adequately addressed in your submitted application:

CMS 43 Application:

- A map or aerial photograph of the proposed site. A picture of the site was provided, but an aerial view provides information pertaining to site features in close proximity to the proposed facility.
- An estimate of the volume of materials on a daily, monthly or annual basis that will be managed at the facility.
- Revised drawing of the facility site. Include the features as identified on the mark-up copy enclosed with this letter.

CMS HRP Application:

- A separate, completed application form for the HRP site. The SR 43 and HRP are different facilities and must have separate applications and documentation.
- A map or aerial photograph of the proposed site.
- Detailed information explaining the proposed storage and solids handling
 processes, including all of the following: how brine will be managed at the site;
 what size tanks will be used; details of the solids separation and filter processes;
 and details of the solidification operations. This information may be on a
 separate sheet and attached to the application.
- Revised drawing of the facility site. Include the features as identified on the mark-up copy enclosed with this letter.
- An estimate of the volume of materials on a daily, monthly or annual basis that will be managed at the facility.

- Disclosure of chemical reagents and MSDS and a description of their function to be used at this site.
- The methods that will be used to document the volume of material received and the final disposition of material, including any solids (if applicable).


Please submit the above information to DOGRM by May 2, 2014. A temporary authorization, in the form of a Chief's order, is required to operate your facility. After the Chief's review, the Chief will determine if an order should be issued.


